do make and appoint this my last will and testament
in manner and form following disavowing and
renouncing all other wills and testaments heretofore made

through the merits of Jesus Christ my savior
And I commit my body to the earth to be decently
buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter mentioned
and 3rdly I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Eliza
Bethany acres of land adjoining William Hammon,
here in undivided possession and interest with her

house hold furniture also my bond in one during
my natural life or wednesshood afterwards to be equally
divided between my three children.

and 4th item the remainder of my land to be equally di-
vided between my three children that is to say my son
John Hammons and my son John Hammons and
my daughter Susannah Hammons.

and 5th item such property as can be spared from this
family over to be sold to pay the leg of the land
and the schooling of my children.

and 6th item that the three children rest of my property
be equally divided between my three children when
they shall come of age

and 7th item that I make and appoint my father John
Hammons and my brother William Hammons Ex-
-ecutors of this my last will and testament.
