

In the Name of God Amen

I Samuel Withers son of Simon Withers and
state of Georgia, being in, a debilitated State of
Mind, but of sound Mind & Memory, thank
to that God for the same, calling to mind the
Mortality of my body, do make this my last Will
& Testament - first I Recommend my body
to be buried in a decent Christian Manner
at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named, and my soul into the hands of
Almighty God Who gave it - And that it
be not to such worldly goods with which it has
pleased God to bless me, I dispose of in the
following Manner Viz,

1st Lincoln County Wills 1800 to 1832

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1. I give to my son Isaac Samuel Withers, five
Dollars as his full proportion of my Estate.
2. I give to James Gray who married my daughter
Rebecca, five Dollars as his full proportion.
3. I give to my son Isaac Isaac Carter or his children
by my daughter, five Dollars -
4. I give to my son Jacob Withers one Hundred Dol-
lars as his full proportion of my Estate -
5. I give to my grand children, Pissilla, son of
Marshall & Daniel, Orphans of my son Stephen
Withers, Twenty five Dollars each as their full propo-
rtion of my Estate -
6. I give unto my beautiful sons Samuel & Daniel
Withers the tract of Land on which I now live
containing

containing three hundred acres more or less bounded
by John C. Gordon, Jacob Gava & the Road leading
from Augusta to Petersburg -

8th I give to my son John Benjamin Elliott.
One Hundred Dollars as his full proportion -

9th I give to my son John Daniel Gray One Hundred
and Dollars as his full proportion -

10th I also give to my beautiful son Daniel Withers
my Negro of name Sampson -

11th I give to my grand son Thomas Withers, son to
my son Daniel Withers my blue coat, sword
man, saddle and bridle -

12th It is my wish that my stock of hogs, cattle &
the balance of my horses be sold and the proceeds
thereof to be equally divided between Daniel
Gray, Daniel Withers & Thomas Withers -

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And I appoint my beautiful son Daniel Withers & my son John
Daniel Gray my Executors to this my Will & Testament
in - hereby Revoking all others by me made.
