I Sarah Hardy, wife of Lincoln County and State of Georgia being indisposed of body but of sound mind and memory, thank almighty God for the same, but owing to the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to see or behold death, make and ordain this my last will and testament. In the first place I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God, who gave it, and my body to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors to be hereafter named. Secondly, as to my worldly goods, with which it has pleased God to bless me, I dispose of in the following manner. (1st) First I desire all my just debts be paid, then my will and desire is that my loving daughter Penelope may have all the money which is due me from the sale of a lot of land I own in the last land lottery, and sold to Joel Lockhart, son of John Lockhart, which amount is as follows: One by Lewis Parks two hundred and fifty, four dollars, one by Sutton Hardy ten dollars, one by Hardy fifteen dollars and fifty cents and two dollars which I have by me. And it is my will and desire that all my debts be paid, and my children be provided for. I appoint all my children Executors, to wit: John Hardy, Henry Hardy, Sutton Hardy, Penelope Hardy and Elizabeth Hardy, children and wife Hardy. I appoint my loving son John Hardy with my much respected friend Lewis Parks of Lincoln County and State of Georgia, Executors to this my last will and testament.
