 Share & Share alike after defraying all my expenses
 Burial &c. &c. It should there be any such charges

Item 4th In the carrying into effect of my last will
 and Testament according to the several directions
 and provisions therein made

I do hereby constitute and appoint my aforesaid nephew
Duncan Lawrence my sole executor to carry the
same into effect - Intestimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this third
day of January one thousand eight hundred
and twenty three -
