Mind And Memory for Which I thank God, but
but calling to mind the Mortality of my body
And knowing it appointed for all men to die
do make this my last Will And Testament in
the first place I Recommend My Soul to God
Who gave it And my Body to be Buried in a
decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors
hereafter named With Regard to my Worldly
Goods, I dispose of in the Following manner
To wit, First I desire is that all my Just-
debts Should be paid, then I Bestow on John
Hamrick Son of my Sister Elizabeth Hamrick
the one half of my Land and here becom to be at
his disposal immediately after my death the
other half of my Land and there becom I bestow
on my Sister Elizabeth Hamrick during her
Natural Life and at her death to be Equally
Divided between Jeremiah Hamrick And Barnett
Hamrick Sons of my Sister Elizabeth Hamrick,
I also Bestow on the said John Hamrick my
Bed and furniture And also all my household
and kitchen furniture to be his at my death, and
I also Appoint the said John Hamrick my Exe-
cutor to this my last Will And Testament Witness
My hand and seal this January 8th 1822
