First I give & leave my daughter Mary Thomas, five dollars, which is to be raised out of my property, I leave my son William [www.georgiapioneers.com](http://www.georgiapioneers.com) is to be raised out of my property, Third I give and leave my daughter Sarah Haury my daughter, a cow and calf, one feather bed & five dollars cash, my four Youngest Children (Viz) Susanna Haury, Thomas Haury, Claborn Haury, & Elizabeth Haury which is clerk & clerk, I leave my Negro man Henry, to my daughter Elizabeth Haury, which said Negro man Henry is to be sold and the price to be paid to Elizabeth Haury.

all the balance of my property to be sold and to be equally divided among Susanna Haury, Thomas Haury, & Claborn Haury, after my last debts is all paid

I do hereby revoke all former Wills & Testaments  
by me made, And do hereby appoint this to be  
my last Will and Test, and I do hereby appoint  
Francis & Taylor & Peyton Haws, to be my executors  
of this my last Will and Testaments, in Writs  
whereof I have set my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> Apr<sup>l</sup>  
1873
