State of Georgia: In the name of God Amen, I Thomas
Lincoln County: Deputy of the County and State aforesaid
as above written, being of sound mind, and knowing to mind
the mortality of my body, and knowing the uncertainty of
a death and that it is appointed for all men once to die, do
hereby constitute & ordain this my last will & testament:
In the first place do recommend my soul to God who gave
it and my body to be decently buried in a christian like man-
ner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named
with regard to the worldly goods it has been blessed with
bestow on me, I give and bequeath in the following manner
(it wits) First I desire that all my Just debts be paid out of
my Estate Lincoln County Wills 1800 to 1830
Judith Dupuy my wife
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whom I now live during her natural life, and plantations
disposed of by myself in my lifetime, Also I bind
unto her my said wife Judith Dupuy two negroes, that is
to say a negro man named Toby and one negro woman
named Kate, Also I bind unto my wife Judith Dupuy one half
of my stock of Horses, cattle, Hogs & Sheep, Also all my Plant-
ations tools, Also as much of my household & kitchen Furni-
ture as she in her pleasure may think proper during
her natural life or widowhood, and in case she my wife
Judith Dupuy should determine that then & in that case
two thirds of the above named property, Except the negroes
Toby and Kate which is hereafter devised away, shall be
taken from her & by my Executors sold at public auction
and the proceeds thereof to be equally divided share and
share alike between my children Martha Dupuy, Mahin
Dupuy, Charlotte Curry, Delia Curry, & Minerva Curry
to them and their heirs forever

Now I give and bequeath unto my son Barth's Dupuy Two negroes
(To wit, one Negro Man named Ned, and one Negro Girl named
-ed Mary) them and their increase to him and his heirs forever.

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Charlotte Curry
one Negro woman named Kate, which Negro woman is loaned
unto my wife Judith Dupuy during her natural life or widow
-hood, her and her increase to her and her heirs forever.

Now I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my son Dempsey
Dupuy, (To wit) Elizabeth Dupuy, Susanna Dupuy,
Sams Dupuy, & Jermerson Dupuy, Two negroes one Negro
Woman named Fanny, and a Negro boy named John;
to be equally divided between them and their ~~heirs~~ increase
between them and their heirs, share and share alike, whenever
the above named Legatee Jermerson Dupuy shall arrive
to the age of Fourteen years, And in case of the death
of said Jermerson Dupuy before his arrival to the age of
Fourteen the equal division shall take place, when the
youngest daughter ~~of said~~ ^{Lincoln County, Wills 1800 to 1832} ^{www.georgiapioneers.com} arrives to the
age of Fourteen years, the other named negroes to be
held by my Executors and their services applied in the
most advantageous way to the benefit of the above named
Elizabeth, Susanna, Sams & Jermerson Dupuy, or to the
surviving one of said Legatees at either of the times above
Specified.

Now I give and bequeath unto my son Malicia Three
negroes, (To wit) Negro boy named Hall & one woman
named Liddy, and one Negro man named Toby at the
death or intermarriage of his mother, them and their in-
-crease to him and his heirs forever.

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Dolly
Walter one Negro boy named Allick to her and her
and her heirs forever.

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Amy
Freemont two Negroes one Girl named Ruth and
one other named Chancy them & their increase to her
and her heirs forever. — Continued on p.

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Winiford Fletcher
two negroes (Sally) one boy (Samuel) and one
girl (Mamod) to her and the lawful heirs of her
body forever.

Now I give and bequeath unto my grand son Thomas Hilgore
one negro boy named Harvey to him and his heirs forever
and also one good feather bed & furniture.

Now I give and bequeath unto my grand son William Hilgore
one negro girl named Kate her & her things as to him and
his heirs forever also one good feather bed and furniture.
I also bequeath that provided either of my grand sons Thomas
or William Hilgore herein named should die before they
arrive to the years of maturity to receive their legacy herein
named, that then & in that case the legacy herein containing
shall be the property of the surviving one.

Now I give and bequeath unto my son-in-law Samuel Fleming
the sum of Five dollars to be paid to him out of my Estate
for him & his heirs forever.

Now I give & bequeath unto my son-in-law Robert Hilgore
the sum of Five dollars to be paid to him by my Executor
out of Lincoln County Wills 1800 to 1832.

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susanna Fleming five
negroes that is to say Rose a negro woman and her four
children them and their increase to her during her natural
life, and after her death of her my daughter Susanna
Fleming I give and bequeath the said negroes Rose and their in-
crease to be equally divided share & share alike between all the
lawful heirs of her body for them and their heirs forever.

Now I give and bequeath all the rest & residue of my Estate
except what is for the use of my wife Judith Dupuy as is
stated in the foregoing part of this my last will and testa-
ment and also a sufficient sum for the support & maintenance
of my wife Judith Dupuy for the term of twelve months
after my decease, to be sold at twelve months bond to and
to be equally divided share and share alike between my
son Bartlett Dupuy, Malcher, Harvey Dupuy the widow of
Samuel Dupuy deceased, and my daughter Charlotte Dupuy
and their heirs forever.

Then I give and bequeath unto my son Bartlett Dupuy Two negroes
 to wit, one Negro Man named Matt and one Negro Girl named
 Mary them and their increase to him and his heirs forever
 Then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Charlotte Barry
 one Negro woman named Cate, which Negro woman is loaned
 unto my wife Judith Dupuy during her natural life or widow
 hood, her and her increase to her and her heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my son Dempsey
 Dupuy (deceased) Elizabeth Dupuy, Susanna Dupuy,
 Jane Dupuy, & Jermerson Dupuy, Two negroes one Negro
 Woman named Fanny, and a Negro boy named John;
 to be equally divided between them and their heirs
 between them and their heirs, share and share alike, whenever
 the above named Legatee Jermerson Dupuy shall arrive
 to the age of Fourteen years, And in case of the death
 of said Jermerson Dupuy before his arrival to the age of
 Fourteen the equal division shall take place, when the
 youngest child of said Jermerson Dupuy shall arrive to the
 age of Fourteen years, the division of said negroes to be
 held by my Executors and their services applied in the
 most advantageous way to the benefit of the above named
 Elizabeth, Susanna, Jane & Jermerson Dupuy, or to the
 surviving ones of said Legatees at either of the times above
 specified

Then I give and bequeath unto my son Malitia Three
 negroes, to wit, Negro boy named Hall & one woman
 named Liddy, and one Negro man named Toby at the
 death of his mother, then and their in-
 crease to him and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly
 Walton one Negro boy named Charlotte her and her
 and her heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary
 Livingston two Negroes one Girl named Liza and
 one other named Chancy them & their increase to her
 and her body heirs forever

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Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Winifred Fletcher
two negroes (Slaves) one boy named Sootrow and one
girl named Nancy, to her and the lawful heirs of her
body forever.

Now I give and bequeath unto my grand son Thomas Hilgore
one negro boy named Sawney to him and his heirs forever
and also one good feather bed and furniture.

Now I give and bequeath unto my grand son William Hilgore
one Negro Girl named Kate her & her ~~things~~ ^{increase} to him and
his heirs forever also one good feather bed and furniture
I also bequeath that provided either of my grand sons Thomas
or William Hilgore herein named should die before they
arrive to the years of maturity to receive their legacy herein
named, that then & in that case the legacy herein contained
shall be the property of the surviving one.

Now I give and bequeath unto my son-in-law Samuel Fleming
the sum of five dollars to be paid to him out of my estate
for him & his heirs forever.

Now I give & bequeath unto my son-in-law Robert Hilgore
the sum of five dollars to be paid to him by my Executor,
out of Lincoln County Wills 1806 to 1832.

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susanna Fleming five
negroes that is to say Rose a negro woman and her four
children them and their increase to her during her natural
life, and after the death of her my daughter Susanna Flem-
ing, I give and bequeath the said negroes Rose and their in-
crease to be equally divided share & share a like between all the
lawful heirs of her body for them and their heirs forever.

Now I give and bequeath all the rest & residue of my estate
except what is for the use of my wife Judith Dupuy as is
stated in the foregoing part of this my last will and testa-
ment and not a sufficiency for the support and maintain-
ance of my wife and the Dupuy, for the term of twelve months
after my decease, to be sold or divided among the heirs to
be equally divided share and share a like between my
son Bartlett Dupuy, Malachi Fleming Dupuy the widow of
Leopold Dupuy deceased, and my daughter Charlotte being
singly or with some competent witnesses to be made to them
and their heirs forever.

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Now I give and bequeath all that property for the use of my wife
as mentioned in the foregoing part of this my last will and
Testaments in case of her death marriage, to be managed as before
Specified, otherwise at her death. Shall be sold and divided equal
share and share alike between my son Bartlett Dupuy, Malchus Dupuy
Sammy Dupuy, widow of Humphrey Dupuy, Rebecca, Charlotte, Henry
Solly, Walter, Anna Covington & Winifred Hatcher, to them and
their heirs forever &

I do hereby constitute and appoint to this my last will &
Testaments, my loving wife Judith Dupuy, Executrix & my son Mal-
chus Dupuy & my son Bartlett Dupuy, Executors to carry into eff-
ect this my last will and Testaments, revoking all other wills
heretofore by me made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand seal this twenty fifth day September 1823
