I do hereby will and bequeath to my beloved daughter
Lucy the wife of Thomas Crawford fifty dollars to her and
her heirs forever. I do hereby will and bequeath to my beloved
daughter Matilda the wife of John Stewart fifty dollars to her
and her heirs forever.

I do hereby will and bequeath to my beloved
daughter Cynthia a certain Negro girl by the name of
Patsy to her and her heirs forever

Lastly, I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my
beloved son Thomas Elliot and William Paschal Executors to
this my last will and testament with full power to carry the
same into effect
