In the same signed manner  
I Thomas Thompson of the County of Lincoln  
and State of Georgia, Being sick of body but  
of sound mind and memory, and knowing  
that it is appointed for all flesh to die &  
believing that my time is now fast drawing  
I do there make Ordain And constitute this  
my last Will and Testament To wit & of saying  
Item 1<sup>st</sup> I will that all my just debts be  
paid out of funds provided hereafter  
for that purpose -  
Item 2<sup>d</sup> I will And Bequeath to my beloved  
Wife Jane Thompson the tract of land  
whereon I now live, being by Estimation \$30,  
more or less more or less, being the best  
of land. I purchased of my father Nathaniel  
Boggs with all and every of his other things  
there belonging, To wit, houses, but here  
James

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House, and household plantation and plantation  
Tools of every Description, also all  
the House hold and Kitchen furniture  
of every Description, with all the Waggons  
Carts, and Carriages and all the Stock  
belonging to the Farm, To Wit, Horses, cattle  
hogs, Sheep and poultry, also my Negro  
man Eldrick, and, Doctor, George George  
Reed, Big Sam and Little Sam and also my  
Negro Woman by, with her present and fut-  
ure Increase to Wit, Eliza, Caroline, and  
Simmy also her and her future Increase  
all of which I will and bequeath To my  
Beloved Wife Jane Thompson, as her House

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and for the support of her and her family of her  
the said Jane Thompson, and all her household  
furniture for her, and also one half of the pres-  
ent crop of grain for the support of the  
family for the year ending for the ensuing year  
Widely, I will that my Distilling stills  
casks and tubs & hogheads and every  
thing there unto belonging with the balance  
of my lands and the residue of my Neg-  
roes, I leave at the disposal of my  
Executors to be Equally Divided Among  
my surviving Children when they be  
come of age or married, Agreeable To the  
Judgment of their good free holders  
that is to say When the first Child comes  
is of age or married he or she shall  
Receive an Equal Dividend of that property

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Set apart for them And When the W. at Age becomes  
of Age or Marries that shall Receive the same as  
the Joint And so on in Rotian throughout. The  
Whole And If the Childrens Joint Increase be-  
come the Oldest. Marrying or becoming of Age And  
the youngest. Marrying or becoming of Age then  
my Desire is that. The surplus be Equally Divi-  
ded Among All my Children, I Also Have All  
my judgments, Executions, Notes And Book  
Accounts in the hands of my Executors to be  
Collected And out of Which I wish all my  
Just debts paid And the Balance to be Equally  
Divided Among All my surviving Heirs at the  
time before appointed for the Division And  
Lastly I Appoint my beloved Wife Jane Heir-  
-ship my Executrix And my son Robert  
R. Horn my Executor And the other my Executors  
to carry out the above and other my Intent And  
I Commit my Soul to God through Christ -  
Amen, Signed Sealed And Executed this  
fourth day of November 1820 -
