 of my wife

My children surviving & do and also lend to my wife my
 Wagon & two horses her choice out of my stock and my cattle
 and nine head of cattle in choice out of my stock and six
 sheep her choice and fifteen head of hogs her choice out of my
 stock all these several articles lastly mentioned together with
 all my plantation tools and house hold furniture I will and
 lend to my wife during her natural life and after her decease
 and after her decease to be equally divided amongst all my chil-
 dren. I also give to my son William McHenry my Negroe woman
 Harma to him for ever I also give to my daughter Army
 Hammock my Negroe man named Jack and I also
 give to my son John McHenry my Negroe man named
 James and all my stock of every kind that is not lent to
 my wife I leave to be equally divided amongst all my
 children and lastly I will and appoint John McHenry
 and William McHenry as executors to this my last will and
 testament.
