 State of Georgia and County of Lincoln Considering the
 uncertainty of this ^{Mortal} life and being of sound and perfect
 Mind and Memory do make and publish this my
 last Will and Testament in manner and form following
 That is to say

first I bind to my beloved wife Anna Rogers, formerly
 Lucy, Peace & Lucy during her natural life and
 also bind to my wife Nancy M'Kinney my house and
 Plantations with all the improvements as it stands during
 her natural life and after her decease I give the
 Negro girl Lucy to my grand daughter Polly Jones &
 the Negro woman Lucy belonging to my daughter Mary
 Jackson and the Negro boy Isaac I give to my son
 John M'Kinney and my plantation after the death
 of my wife Lincoln County Wills 1796-1808

My children surviving & dead and also bind to my wife my
 Waggon & two horses her choice out of my Stock and my Hides
 and seven head of cattle or choice out of my Stock and six
 hogs her choice and fifteen head of hogs her choice out of my
 Stock all these several articles lastly mentioned together with
 all my plantation tools and house hold furniture I will and
 bequeath to my wife during her Natural life and after her decease
 and after her decease to be equally divided amongst all my chil-
 dren. I also give to my son William Mc Kinney my Negroe Woman
 Hanna to his heirs for ever I also give to my daughter Ann
 Hammock my Negroe man named Jack. and I also give
 to my son John Mc Kinney my Negroe man named
 James, and all my Stock of every kind that is not left to
 my wife. I leave to be equally divided amongst all my
 children. and lastly I will and appoint John Mc Kinney
 and William Mc Kinney executors to this my last will and
 testament.
