

In the name of God amen I William Jones of the County of Lincoln and State of Georgia do constitute and ordain this my last Will and Testament thus. I give and bequeath unto daughter Elizabeth Bird our Negro man Danie and our Negro Woman an darcy to her and her heirs for ever.

Item. I give to my daughter Mary Gethum our Negro woman named Aggy and her increase which she now has possession of to her and her heirs forever. I lend to my daughter Susannah Parly our Negro boy Samus and one bay horse called Lolly and one Cow & Calf and one hundred dollars during her natural life them to be equally divided amongst the heirs of her body.

Item I give to my daughter Jerry Postlets our Negro boy Luther that she now has in possession and one Cow & Calf and one hundred and twenty five dollars to her and her heirs forever.

I Item I give to my daughter Mitty Moring my Negro woman Phillis and one hundred and fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Fanny Jones my two Negro girls namely Isabella & Betsy and her d'paratures to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Sally Jones my Negro woman Violet and Tom her child one feather bed & furniture to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give to my 3 grand Children heirs of my son John Jones one & five hundred dollars to be equally divided between them but to remain in the hands of my Executors until they come of age and money and not to bear interest until they shall be of age money to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give to my son William Jones 175 acres of land more or less the bounds to run as follows it being the place where I now live beginning on Newford Creek on Thomas Waller

I do hereby give a long the said line to the argenta road  
thence up the said road. to the head of the drain opposite  
to the house where James Bird now lives thence down  
the said drain to the near branch running thro the blawata  
thence down the said branch to the creek thence  
down the said creek to the beginning and one my own beysom  
cats and one feather bed and one small colt and one cow and  
Calf to him and his heirs forever

I then I give to my son Henry Jones all the remaining tract of  
land where I now live or the place where James Bird lives  
175. more or less beginning in the road at the head of the said  
drain thence down the said drain to the said Branch  
to the said creek thence up the said creek. a long owners  
line thence a long the said line to Anthony's line thence  
by Bastons line thence as the line goes the said road.  
thence up the said road to the beginning at the head of the  
drain also my Negro man Gabriel and one feather  
bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

A B. I give to my before mentioned son William Jones my  
Negro man called young Peter and one Negro woman  
Lehorloff and the one half of all the remaining part of my  
property real or personal not mentioned in my will and  
the said William is to pay the one half of my debt debts  
and the one half of all the legacies above bequeathed in cash  
and here after bequeathed to my grand son William Jones

I also give to my before mentioned son Henry Jones  
my Negro man Samy and my Negro man called old  
Peter and the other half of my property real or personal  
not bequeathed in this my will out of which in the said  
Henry is to pay the other half of the money above bequeathed  
and here after bequeathed to my grand son above mentioned  
and the other half of my debt debts

I then I give to my grand son William Jones two hundred  
and fifty dollars to be paid to the said William by my two  
sons out of this last legacy bequeathed thence the money to be  
paid out in hand if the above mentioned Henry and

of fully that amount the money not to come interest till  
 the said William come of age, My desire is that my  
 son Henry Jones & William Jones, be my Executors and they by  
 constitute them as such if they both may chuse to do so  
 and sit my hand and affix my seal this thirteenth day  
 of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
