Lincoln County, William Mosley of the
State of County aforesaid

Being Weak of body but of Sound Mind and
Perfect Memory and knowing the Uncer-
tainty of Life and the Certainty of Death
do Constitute and Appoint this My Last
Will and Testament - In Man and Kind
form following -

I Give and Bequeath to My Beloved Wife Rachel
a Mosley during her Natural Life the
following Property Viz, the Tract of
Land Whereon I now reside contain-
ing four Hundred & Sixty Acres Including
the two Lots I have lately purchased of the
Hammond & others of the State of Georgia
Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs &c. With all the
Working Tools & household furniture of my
Wagon & Car and the following Negroes -
Namely Job, Tom, Jimmy, Hannah Mary
Annie, George & Sarah All the above pro-
perty I Give to My Beloved Wife Rachel aforesaid
during her Natural Life -

I Give Also to My Son Benjamin Mosley
Four Hundred & Thirty Acres of Land
After the Death of My Beloved Wife Viz,
the One half of the Land that I have sent
My beloved Wife during her Natural Life &
have given to her by Deed to be delivered
him by My Beloved Wife at his marriage
One Horse Bridle & Saddle Which

He has now in his possession of about
some of some stock & household furniture
such as she may see cause to give him as
she can spare.

I then give to my son Jacobson Masley the
Balance of the tract of land that is not
given to my son W. Masley that there that
to my Beloved Wife to be Equally divided
between the two Benjamin & Jacobson after
the death of my Beloved Wife & also her
Negro boy named Wilcher & her horse
bridle & saddle & my gun and stock &
household furniture Equally with Benjamin
or as she can spare.

I then give to my daughter Winney Florence
fifty Acres of Land which they have had in
these ^{part of} Lincoln County Wills 1800 to 1832
Nancy J. G. ^{Woman} ^{land} ^{which}
which she has already in her possession
one horse two cows & calves but no furniture
& stock which she has already in her poss-
ession.

I give to my Daughter Nancy Florence
one Negro Woman named Jude & one white
boy named one boy & half & some hogs which
she has already in her possession & her father
bed of furniture & household furniture which
she has already in her possession. As for as
I then give to my Daughter Edith Underhill
one Negro Girl named also two hogs & half
& two cows & pigs & one father bed of furniture
which she has already in her possession.
I then give to my Daughter Elizabeth the

12. One Negro Woman named Maryna Two
Cows & Calves & some Hogs & bed & furniture
Which she has already in her possession
Item I give to my Daughter Lucy One Hundred
acres of Land Which I purchased at
Sheriff's sale beginning of Hunter & Colston
on the Waters of Little Branch & One Negro
Girl call'd Aggrey One father Box & furniture
of other furniture such as my Wife can
afford -

Item I give to my Daughter Ruby One Hundred
acres of One of a 1/2 acres of Land Which I now
own in the purchase formerly Baldwin lying
on Little Turkey Creek Which I now have
a grant for. And One Negro Girl call'd Vinny
& One father Box & furniture & other furniture
as my Wife may see cause to spare to her
the said Ruby -

Item I give to my Daughter Cynthia the
Balance of the tract of Land lying in the
purchase that is not Will'd to Ruby the Land
to be Equally divided Between my Three daugh-
ters Ruby & Cynthia & One Negro Girl.
I give to my daughter Cynthia call'd Charles
& One father Box & furniture & other
furniture as my Wife may see cause to spare
- but the aforesaid mentioned Negro's
Wife, got. Tom, Jim, my, Hannah, Mary -
my Wife, to be disposed of in the follo-
w manner, I think either of the aforesaid

13th Children have the Misfortune to loose either
of them they are by sickness or other Means they
are to be of the Aforesaid mentioned Negroes
so that they shall be Equal in Value With the
Elder Children. Viz the following Children Lamy
Mary Isaborn & Cynthia they are to be made
equal either of them have the Misfortune to
loose them Negroes as aforesaid & the other —
Among the Aforesaid Children the Remainder of
them After the death of my beloved Wife to be
Equally divided Amongst all my Children
Viz Winney, Nancy, Benjamin, Edith Elizabeth
Lamy Mary Isaborn & Cynthia and I do hereby
constitute and Appoint my Beloved Wife
Rachel Mosely my Executrix & my son
Benjamin my Co-Executor to their my last
Will & Testament.
