And her share of my feather bed, bedstead

fiftieth. It is my desire, that the residue of
my Estate be Equally Divided between my
Sons William and Benjamin Reynolds

My Son Isaac Martin & James Picket, my
Grand Daughter, Elizabeth Hart & Catharine
Reynolds daughter to my Son Robert Reynolds

And my grand son William Hart, Each
share of one feather bed, bedstead & furniture

Which I give to my Son Benjamin Reynolds
And that part which fall to the lot of my Son
Isaac Martin Picket, I give into the hands of
my son Robert Reynolds, in trust for my said
Son in Law Martin Picket -
