can't expect live to a much greater age, and it having pleased
God in his goodness to bless me with some of the goods of this
world, which I must leave, I have determined to do so by will and
that in the following manner (viz, Into the hands of my
Creator, I give my Soul who gave it to me and my Body
I recommend to be buried in a decent Christian manner
by my friends -

Item 1. My will and desire is that all my Just debts be by
my Executors who I will herein after appoints to this my
last will and testament, be paid; as well as all necessary
expenses in distributing my Estate real & personal.

Item 2. I Lincoln County will \$800 to 1832 personal by
the www.georgiapioneers.com provide, with the dwelling
house and out houses, Stocks of all kinds, providing that
Mary remain at my death & her Negroes, Harriett and
Charles, a woman & boy remain in the possession & control
of my beloved Wife Orucilla Wright & provided this is
the longest live.

Item 3. I desire that my Executors pay to my daughter Lucy
Storace, Wife of Orury Storace as the full portion of all my
Estate real and personal for her and that share of said Estate
the sum of one dollar, after the decease of myself & Wife

Item 4. I desire that my Executors pay over to my son William
Wright Junr. in trusts for his grand children, the sum
of the body of my daughter, Mary Barnett (formerly
Mary Storace) provided any of their children should
be minors the portion or amount that my said daughter
would be entitled to provided she was to receive the
same. I give the parts of all my estate after paying
all my debts & legacies before incited, but should my

Said grand Children by my said daughter all be of age at the time of my death to my Wife, that my Executors will pay to them as they may call, their proportionable part of the said parts as aforesaid of my Estate real & personal after the same has been disposed of to the best advantage for all concerned and that to be in full of my said daughters portion.

Item 5th To my following eleven Children by Sally Wright Wife of Lewis Wright, Elizabeth Wright, William Wright, John Richard Wright, John Wright, Reuben Wright, David Wright, Amelia Wright, Samuel Wright, Nathaniel Wright and Benjamin Wright, I give all the residue of my Estate, real & personal, share & share a like, after paying the debts expenses &c. and the one Twelfth part to the heirs of the body of my said daughter Mary Barnett formerly Mary Howell.

Item 6th My further will and desire is that my Sons Samuel Wright & Benjamin Wright be my Executors to this my last Will & Testament, requiring all others and to them I Confide to carry the same into effect as veritable to the thinking thereof in Witness Whereof I have unto Set my hand and affix my Seal this Sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord, One thousand Eight Hundred Twenty three

considering that there is a time for all to die, and having witnessed
the many sad consequences of intestacy and law suits about
dead mens estates, I think proper under God as far as I can to
appoint ~~Lincoln County~~ Wills 1800 to 1832 & had
pleased ~~myself~~ georgiapioneers.com composed of on my decease
and in the first place I recommend my soul to God who gave
it me & my body to be buried in a Christian like manner
at the discretion of my beloved wife whom I have appointed my
only & sole executrix of this my last will and testament -
2^d As touching my worldly estate, I give and bequeath to every part
thereof real and personal of whatever the same may consist and
every kind thereof to my beloved wife Elizabeth Dooley to her and
her heirs forever, I lastly appoint my dearly beloved wife Execu-
trix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking & annulling
all former wills by me made - In testimony whereof I
hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th day of Nov^r 1824
