

Will of Mrs. Juliette M. Ashley
State of Georgia Lowndes County.
I, Juliette M. Ashley of said State
and County being of sound and disposing
mind and memory do make this
my last will and testament.

Item 1st

It is my desire to provide for my
unmarried daughters, Florence Ashley
and Virginia M. Ashley, so far as my
property will do so as long as they or either
of them shall remain single, and with
that object in view, I give and bequeath
to them - my daughters - the said Florence
and Virginia M. Ashley, all my property
both real and personal to be theirs jointly
so long as both shall remain unmarried
and upon the marriage or death, unmarried
of either of them the same, to descend to the
single one or survivor subject to the lim-
itations hereinafter named.

Item 2nd

Upon the marriage of both my daughters
Florence and Virginia M. I desire and direct
that the above mentioned property, descend
to and become the property of my grand
daughters Emma Tyler (daughter of James
and Louisa Tyler) and Juliette M. C. Braswell
(daughter of James C. and Maria Braswell)
provided both are alive and unmarried at
that time. If they are not, and either
is unmarried and living, then the same
to be hers until her marriage or death
and upon the marriage or death of all the
legates above named, the said property
to be divided among my children or their
living descendants, according to the laws
of this State governing distribution of
estates at that time.

Item 3rd

Should any of the aforesaid mentioned legates
marry or die prior to my death, I desire
for it to have no effect upon this Will.

further that it affects her or their share and I wish it to affect the share on intestacy of the one so dying or marrying precisely the same as if said death or marriage had occurred subsequent to my death.

Item 4th

It is not intention or desire in writing my property as above to restrain or dis-empower my daughters or grand daughters from marrying, but I do so in the belief and hope that when each marries that she will have some one able and willing to take care of her and in the belief that the one or ones remaining single will be most apt to lead the usual life of the property.

Item 5th

To my beloved son Edward William Ashley who has generously suggested the above disposition of ~~the~~ property, and to my son O. R. Ashley, John A. Smith providing for them with such a sufficiency that he requires nothing of my hands, and to my daughters Sue M. Stapler and Maud A. Bradwell who have already married, I give the blessings and good wish of a loving mother.

Item 6th

I hereby constitute and appoint my son Edward William Ashley, Executor of my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 28 day September 1891.
