

Will and Testament of John D. Barnes

State of Georgia Lowndes County.

I, J. D. Barnes of said State and County do make this my last will and testament, being at this time of sound and disposing mind and memory.

Item 1st I will that all my debts be paid by the executor hereinafter named.

Item 2nd After the payment of all my debts by my executor named in this will I give and bequeath my entire estate of realty and personally to my wife Rachelle E. Barnes.

Item 3rd I hereby appoint S. B. Goanvin of said County as executor of this will and relieve him from making returns to the ordinary as required by law, unless he sees proper to make such returns, and then only as he may see proper.

Item 4th It is my will and I hereby direct that my said executor sell the northern portion of my farm, the place I now live on, on the public road North of Valdosta, for the purpose of paying my debts.
