

Will of Mrs. Mary Ann Bass.

State of Georgia Lowndes County.

I, Mary Ann Bass of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament.

Item first. I give bequeath to my Husband James R Bass the following Property, to-wit:
