

Last Will and Testament of J P Creech deceased

State of Georgia
Lowndes County

I, J P Creech being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament.

- First I desire and direct that any debts I may owe at my death be paid as speedily as possible.
- Second I give, bequeath and devise all my property, both real and personal, to my beloved wife, Rosa Creech, and my child or children by her share and share alike. In the event I should leave no children by her then I desire that all my property shall go to my said wife. This bequest is made to my said wife in lieu of all her Dower.
- Third I hereby appoint my said wife testamentary Guardian (without bond) of my said child or children by her, with full power and authority to receive and take charge of the share or portion of such child or children and to manage and control the same without restraint and as she sees fit. I authorize her to invest the same at her discretion and to change the investment at her pleasure without any order or the permission of any Court. I relieve my said wife from making returns to any Court of her acts and doings in the premises, either as executrix of this my last will or as testamentary Guardian of my children.
- Fourth I hereby constitute and appoint my said wife Rosa Creech Executrix of this my last will and testament and authorize her to sell either at public or private sale any property whether real or personal and to manage my estate as she thinks best.
- This twentieth day of October eighteen hundred and eighty nine (1889).
