

Last Will of W. A. Ray.

State of Georgia, County Berrien.

I, W. A. Ray of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament .

Item 1st. I desire and direct that my body shall be buried in a decent and Christian like manner and that my just debts be paid as soon as possible after my death .

Item 2nd.n I Give to my beloved Mother Mary A. Ray all of my personal goods consisting of wearing apparel consisting of valises trunks etc. Two Thousand Dollars life policy in the Security Mutual Co., One Thousand Dollars life policy in the Fidelity Mutual Insurance Co. And one thousand Dollars life policy in the Providence Saving Life Insurance Company . The last named policy being now assigned to D. C. Ashley to secure a debt approximately Four hundred and Fifty Dollars.

Item 3d. I nominate and appoint as my executor of this my last will and testament, My Brother Thos. M. Ray to take full and complete charge of all of my estate collect all life policies to pay all of my debts, and to deliver the residue to my beloved Mother , Mary A. Ray . I Further direct that he be not required to give bond to the Ordinary of said County or to make any returns of his transactions, he to make such settlements as he shall deem wise and prudent for the interest of my estate.
