

Will of Mrs. G. E. A. Slater

State of Georgia Lowndes County.

Intending this to be my last Will and Testament I hereby revoke all wills heretofore made by me

Item 1

I hereby give and bequeath to my son W. B. Slater and to my daughter Delia L. Slater, James Slater and Edith H. Slater, all my property both real and personal to be divided equally between them, share and share alike from all of them on living at my death if not then to the survivors or survivor

Item 2

I do not make the foregoing bequest to children therein named because of a lack of equal love for all my children, but because I consider three of my children to wit James Slater, James L. Slater, L. O. Slater, Charles A. Slater, L. Slater, & Josephine Griffith better able to take care of themselves and because of of sanctions said bequest

Item 3

I nominate as my executor or executors whomsoever the majority of all my children shall ask so such the selection to be made, writing and filed with the majority of the County

Item 4

I exempt my executor or executors from the duty of giving bond or making annual return to the State
