

Last Will and Testament of Franklin Sully

Georgia Lowndes County
I, Franklin Sully of said State and County
being of sound and disposing mind and memory
do make this my last will and testament.

Item first. I desire that all my just debts in-
cluding burial expenses, be paid by my executor
to be him after named, as speedily as possible.

Item second. I desire that all my property
be sold by my executor herein after named and
after said sale and the money is collected, I
desire that my beloved son J. M. Sully shall
have five hundred dollars in cash out of the
proceeds of said property both real and
personal.

Item third. After my son J. M. Sully has received
five hundred dollars out of the proceeds of the sale
of my property, I desire that remainder and I
hereby give and bequeath the remainder to my
children then living or their heirs except N. E. Sully
and Polly Burkhalter, who I give nothing whatever
of my estate. They already having received more
than their pro rata share of my estate.

Item fourth. I hereby constitute my son J. M.
Sully executor of this my last will and testament
and direct him to divide the remainder of my
estate after having received five hundred
dollars in cash himself, among my other chil-
dren or their heirs except N. E. Sully and Polly
Burkhalter, share and share alike that is equally.
