of the County of Macon and State of Georgia being
of sound and disposing mind and memory and
being desirous to settle my worldly affairs while I
have strength so to do, do make and publish this
my last Will and testament hereby revoking all
Wills by me at any time heretofore made
And first I bequeath my soul to go a christian
And my body I desire to be buried in a christian
like manner and worldly Estate I dispose of as
follows

First That all my debts be paid

Secondly I give to my daughter Sophronia Minters my
Negro Woman Minda and her increase and her two
Children Eliza and Solia and their future increase
to have and to hold during her natural life
for her own proper use and benefit and at her
death to go to her children and best in said
Children a fee simple till

Thirdly I give to the children of Mr. deceased daughter
Mary Carol the sum of ten Dollars

Fourthly I give to John D Alfieri my son ten Dollars

Fifthly I give to Ruthy McCarty my daughter ten Dollars

Sixthly I give to Crashy Alfieri my son ten Dollars

Seventhly I direct that the above sums of ten Dollars

amounting to Forty Dollars be raised from the sale

of a Sufficient amount of stock for that purpose

Eighthly I further direct that all my household

and Kitchen Furniture and the balance of my stock

over and above the value and amount of raised in

the seventh item and all other effects of mine

not herein enumerated go to & belong to my

daughter Sophronia Minters aforesaid as she

receives the negroes

Ninthly The aforesaid property I will and direct that

not be subject to the debts of the husband of my

daughter Sophronia aforesaid that may be

or may have been contracted

Tenthly I do appoint Quincy M. Mather

 Truly, In Witness whereof I the said Elizabeth
 Algiers have to this my Will set my hand and
 affixed my seal this the twentieth day of
 April One Thousand eight hundred and
 fifty nine (1859)
