uncertain, make this my last will and
Testament.

I give and bequeath to my son Simon Cox one hundred
acres of land, it being the East half of Lot 40 in the
1st District of formerly Muscogee but now Macon County.

I give and bequeath to my son Henry, ~~One~~ hundred acres
of land, the west half of Lot 40 in the 1st District of
originally Muscogee but now Macon County, the half to
include the house and settlement on which I now live.
It is my desire that my daughter Mary shall have the
East half of Lot 40, 40 in the 1st District of originally
Muscogee but now Macon County.

I give and bequeath to Betsy, my oldest daughter one
dollar, to my son John one dollar, to my daughter Mar-
garet Whigham one dollar, to my daughter Mary
Law one dollar, - I also give and bequeath to my wife
Sarah one dollar.

I desire my body to be buried in a decent & christian
like manner.

I wish all my debts if there be any, to be paid out of
the balance of my property, then what remains not
disposed of, to be equally divided between my sons
Simon & Henry, and my daughter Mary.

I do appoint my friend George Williams Jun. to be
my executor, and desire that he may carry out the
contents of this will strictly.
