I John Hiley of said State and County, being of advanced age, and knowing that I must shortly depart this life, doow it right and proper both as respects myself and family, that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me, do therefore make this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

1st Item, I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, suitable to my condition and circumstances in life.

2^d Item, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors, hereinafter appointed, as I am unwilling my Creditors should be delayed in their rights, especially as there is no necessity for delay.

3rd Item, I give, bequeath and direct to my beloved wife Rebecca, with whom I have spent the best part

of my life, the following lots of land, namely, Numbers
as follows, County three (23) Twenty four (24) Foot one
(41) Forty two (42) Eight (8) Seventy four (74) in the County,
and State above written, containing about twelve hundred
and one fifteen acres, (1215) And upon which are situated
my residence and farm, And also all my horses
mules, cattle, hogs, sheep and whatever other stock I
may have, Also my carriage, wagons, carts and all
my farming and plantation utensils and equipments
and also all my household and kitchen furniture,
And I also further bequeath to the said Rebecca the fol-
lowing Negroes, namely, Ishmael, a man of about
forty five years of age, Rose, a woman, about twenty
years of age, Emily, a girl about two years old, Caleb, a
man about forty five years of age, Calvin, a boy about
fifteen years of age, Maria, a woman about thirty
years of age, Elija, a boy about twelve years of age,
Joe, a boy about six years old, Robert a boy about four
years old, Florence, a girl about three years old, Frank
a boy about four months old, Wash, a man about
thirty five years of age, Charlotte, a woman about
thirty years old, Andrew a boy about fifteen years
old, Violet, a girl about eleven years old, Candace,
a girl, about seven years old, Harry a boy about five
years old, Wade a man about twenty two years of age,
Lucy a woman about forty years of age, Disney, a wo-
man about twenty two years of age, Joshua a man
about twenty four years of age, and Chloe, a woman
about thirty years of age,

I make this bequest of my property aforesaid mentioned
to my beloved wife Rebecca, as my worthy trustee to
hold said property in trust during her natural life,
for the benefit of our children in common, namely,
Jacob Hiley, George Hiley, Mary Anderson, Susan C.
Hiley, David Hiley and Samuel Hiley, with the privilege
of making an equal and just distribution of the same
amongst our children, the said Jacob, George, Mary,
Susan, David and Samuel, at any time she may
deem suitable after my demise, reserving first and

Always enough for a decent support for himself during
the natural life.

4th Item, The residue of my property, both real and personal
at wherever and whatever it may be, I bequest to my beloved
wife Rebecca with the same dispositions and for the same
purposes as that above mentioned.

5th Item, I appoint my worthy Son in Law Charles W.
Anderson Trustee for his present wife Mary Anderson my
daughter, to take charge of and manage for her and her child
dear, all that portion of my estate which shall fall to her
at its final distribution, said property to be except from
the debts and liabilities of the said Charles or any future hus-
band.

6th Item, I appoint my son Jacob Hiley Trustee for my
daughter Susan C Hiley, to take charge of and manage
all that portion of my estate which shall fall to her
at its final distribution, which property shall be ex-
cept from the debts and liabilities, control and dispo-
sition of any husband or husband, she may ever
marry.

7th Item, I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
wife Rebecca, Executrix and my son Jacob Hiley Executor
of this my last will and Testament.
