Estate consisting of part of lot of land 1804

Article 2nd I likewise give to my said wife Jane
all my Stock Horses Cattle & Hogs to & for
her during her natural life and after her
death to my youngest son John to him and
his heirs forever likewise all my household
and Kitchen furniture and
plantation tools I likewise constitute
and appoint my said wife Jane
Meeks sole Executor of this my last
will and testament
