personal should be sold and if she takes her
dower for all the ballance of my property
to be sold and all my just debts be paid
and my burial expenses also and after
that it is my will and desire that the
products of the sale of all of said

property to be equally divided share and share
able between my wife Hannah Whiggins and
my daughter Elizabeth A. Chealy and my daughters
Martin & Peter three children to draw their
mother's part Willy & Higgins Hannah M.
Peck James C. Whiggins Malvina A. Whiggins
Eli A. V. Whiggins George W. Whiggins & Mary A.
Whiggins It is also my will and desire that
at my death Arris & Newton should take
charge of all my Estate with real & personal
and of disposing of it at publick outcry
and settling of all my just debts and burial
Expenses to divide the same equally with
my wife and nine children as above named

wife of Asa H. Peck and her children that
she now has or may have hereafter by her
present husband or any future husband

my next son Humphrey about fifteen hundred of all
worth one thousand Dollars and at my death
my daughter Hannah McPeak and her children
it to have enough out of the the balance of my
property to make her and her children equal with
the rest of my children the said property so
bequeathed to my daughter and her children
is not to be subject to the debts or Contracts
of her present husband O B Peak or any
future husband the said property is not to
be subject to her said bond disposition in any
manner what so ever.

And my friend Adair C Newton appointed
trustee of the property given and bequeathed
to my daughter Hannah McPeak and all her
children by the first article of this Codicil is
also constituted and appointed trustee of the
property bequeathed and given said Hannah
McPeak and all her children by this Codicil
this 22nd January 1888
