has blessed me I do therefore make this my
last will and Testament

First I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christian like manner
suitable to my circumstances and conditions
in life. My Soul I trust shall return
to God who gave it as I hope for Salvation
through the merits and atonement of the
kind and Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
Secondly I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid by my Executors hereinafter named
and appointed

Thirdly I give bequeath and devise to my beloved
wife Nancy S. Moon all my houses and Lands
lying in said County containing three hundred
and twenty one acres more or less also all
my Stray Lands also all my Stock of all
kinds also all my household and Kitchen
furniture in fine all my Estate without
limitation or reserve

Fourthly I desire and direct that if my wife
Nancy S. Moon have him or heirs of
me that it or they come in and share

I equal with my wife Nancy S. Moon

Fifthly I hereby constitute and
appoint my wife Nancy S. Moon
Executrix of this my last will and
Testament this August 6th 1846
