Constitute and appoint this my last will
and Testament that is to say I resign my
soul into the hands of God who gave it
and my ^{body} ^{after} death to be buried in a decent
Christian burial & as touching such worldly
estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with
I dispose of in the manner following to wit

First My debts if any to be paid
Second To my son Crawford W Long I give
my State bonds to the amount of one thousand
dollars and two thousand Dollars in Cash
making together the sum of three thousand
dollars and I also leave him one fourth
part of my Georgia Rail Road and Banking
Company Stock of which I may die possessed
at and after the death of my beloved wife
Elizabeth but the Rail Road Stock not to
come into his possession until after the
death of my beloved wife Elizabeth

Third To my son Henry R Long I give Ben
Charity Perry Frank Country Gabriel Cleveland
and Joseph and future income and
I also leave him one fourth part of my Georgia
Rail Road ~~and~~ Banking Company Stock
of which I may die possessed at and after the
death of my beloved wife Elizabeth but the
Rail Road Stock not to come into his possession
until after the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth

Fourth To my Daughter Sarah A Mitchell I give the
following negroes to wit old Dey Manora the
child & future income and the following children
of Dey to wit Dey Augustine Mitty and James Wiley
future income and ~~one fourth~~ dollars in cash

and I also leave her one fourth part of my
Georgia Rail Road & banking Company
stock of which I may die possessed at and
after the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth
but the Rail Road stock not to come into her
possession until after the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth

Fifth To my Daughter Elizabeth Annanida I give
the following negroes to wit Caroline & her six
children to wit Antley Osborn Judy Widdah Laura
& Silas & future increase Mariah & her child & future
increase also after the death of my beloved wife
Elizabeth I leave to my said Daughter Elizabeth A
old Mary Mahaly & her three children & future
increase but not to come into her possession
until after the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth
also to leave her Piano & bed & furniture horse stock &c
& such other property as my beloved wife Elizabeth
shall set apart for her in the way of house keeping
so as to make her equal to the other children
And whereas it is my wish further to provide
for my said daughter Elizabeth A in such a
manner that she may live comfortably during
her life and for that purpose I hereby and by these
present will constitute and appoint George
W Long Henry R Long and Giles Mitchell Trustees
to manage the money & Rail Road stock for the use of
my said daughter Elizabeth A as herein after set a part
for that purpose to wit I leave the sum of Six thousand
five hundred dollars in cash or good notes to be
paid over by my Executors herein after named
to said Trustees and the proceeds arising from the
same to be by said Trustees paid over to my said
daughter Elizabeth A from time to time as she
may desire also after the death of my beloved
wife Elizabeth I leave one fourth part of my
Georgia Rail Road & banking Company stock
of which I may die possessed to be by my said
Executors as herein before expressed turned over
into the hands of said Trustees to be by them managed
the same as the other property herein before set a part

And the proceeds paid over to my said daughter Elizabeth At the same as the proceeds of the Corp and all managed in the same way - provided also that in no case shall the cash notes or Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company stock be changed in any way or manner whatsoever so as to defeat my intentions in this will as herein before expressed but during the life of my said daughter Elizabeth At she may dispose of said cash notes and Georgia Rail Road Stock by Will as she may deem proper to take place after her death

Sixth It is my wish that all my lands Lands with the exceptions of the lands lying and being around Danielsville and the Town lots in Danielsville also the blacksmith and shop to be sold by my Executors herein after named at public or private sale find at such time and place as they may deem advisable and the money arising from the same shall be applied to the payment of the Legacies herein ^{before} set apart the balance of said legacies to be paid out of the notes and accounts and any other monies which may be raised from my said Estate

Seventh To my beloved wife Elizabeth I give my lands whereon I now live lying and being around Danielsville also what Town lots I own in said Village of Danielsville also the following negroes to wit John & Kelly and their ~~children~~ Six children future increase and Peter - all my bonds notes and accounts which remain over and above paying the debts and legacies herein before set apart all the dividend on my Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company stock during her life the lands around Danielsville supposed to contain from four to five hundred acres all my personal Estate of every description not already nor hereafter disposed of with the exception of my Georgia Rail Road Stock to be held and enjoyed by her as her own right and property with power to dispose of it

as she may think proper by Will or otherwise
And whereas I have left to my daughter Elizabeth
At the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth old
Mary Mahaly and her three children ^{in more}
it is my wish that old Mary Mahaly & children
should remain in the possession of my wife
during her life and at her death to be the property
- of my said daughter Elizabeth the dividends on
my Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company stock
to be by my said Executor paid over to my beloved
wife Elizabeth as said dividends may be declared
but after the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth
the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company
stock to be divided as herein before provided for

Eighth I hereby appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth
my Executor and Crawford M Perry Giles
Mitchell & Henry R Long my Executors
to carry this my last Will and Testament
into effect
