Item 4th I give & bequeath to my Grand Children the offspring of the Body of my daughter Elizabeth Key deceased wife of Calbot Key - a Childs part part of my Estate to be Ratably & Equally divided amongst them to them & their Heirs forever —

Item 5th I give & bequeath to my daughter Deliah Key, George Keys Wife a Childs part of my Estate to her & her Heirs forever

Item 6th I give & bequeath to my grand Children, Children of my son Bolley Embry deceased. a Childs part of my Estate to be Ratably & Equally divided amongst them to them & their Heirs forever —

Item 7th I give & bequeath to my grand Children - the offspring of the body of my daughter Charlotte Glen deceased, John Glen wife five dollars to be Ratably & Equally divided amongst them to them & their Heirs forever —

Item 8th I give & bequeath to my daughter Sally (Sally Bowles, Martia Bowles, Wife - the one half of a Childs part of my Estate to her & her Heirs forever. and the other half part of a Childs part of my Estate I give & bequeath to her son Nathan Gains Bowles to him & his Heirs forever

Item 9th I give and bequeath to my daughter Maryanna Syntha Saunders. (William Saunders, Wife - a Childs part of my Estate to her & her Heirs forever —

Having now off my children, because they are young
 & things of value, which I have charged them with in a Book
 of Accounts which I have kept against them it is my Will
 & I direct my Executors in a final settlement with the
 Legates, to recognize the Charge against them respectively
 & which Charge is to be considered as so much the equity
 of their proportionate part of my Estate - and now when
 my wife & myself are dead, I leave it at the discretion of
 my Executors to make sale of my property for Cash or
 on a Credit & to fill in such way & manner as may seem
