and State of said being afflicted

in body but preserving my common mind do consider the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do hereby constitute publish and declare the following to be my last will and Testament

Item 1st After my decease I wish my body to be buried and decently buried -

Item 2nd I desire all my just debts to be paid

Item 3rd I have already given to my son William B. Bolton one horse bridle and saddle one cow and calf one bed and furniture and I make no further provision for him until my wife Martha N. Bolton's death or widowhood

Item 4th I have given to my son Thomas B. Bolton I consider as much as I have to William and I make no further provision for him until my wife Martha N. Bolton's death

Item 5th I desire and give to my son Elijah B. Bolton I desire and give to my son Washington B. Bolton

Bolton one horse saddle and saddle one cow and
calf one bed and furniture to each of them as they
become of age and I make no further provision for
them until my wife Martha S Bolton's death
Item 6th I give to my daughter Peninnah Carter one bed
and furniture one cow and calf and to my
daughters Mary S Bolton Susan S Bolton and
Martha S Bolton one bed and furniture one cow
and calf to each of them as they become of age
Item 7th I do hereby specify the foregoing and following
I constitute and appoint my wife Martha S Bolton
and my son William B Bolton after my death
to take charge of all my Estate both real and
personal as fully as I myself now the same during
the life of my wife Martha S Bolton or widow
without making and returns to Court as required
by law

Item 8th After the death of my wife Martha S Bolton
or in her marriage I wish an equal division of all
effects that may remain of my Estate among my children
