I Samue Bellum of the State of Georgia and
County of Madison being sick and weak in body
but sound of mind. And knowing that death
is appointed for all mine to die. Do publish
this to be my last will and testament - revoking
& disanulling all other wills by me made - In
presence I First it is my Will and desire That
my body be decently Interred by my friends and
Churchwmen and I Give and bequeath my soul to
Almighty God who gave it in hope of its glorious
resurrection with him

Item 1st. It is my Will and desire that all my
Just debts be paid out of my Estate and the
remainder to be disposed of in the following
manner.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my Wife
after my Just debts be paid all the
balance of my Estate during her natural
life or Widowhood and in case she should
die many years before I should be equally divided

among my Wife and Children
Item 3^d It is my Will that my Executors and
Executrix sell my lot of land situate in
Chattanooga County for the best price that can be
obtained & 75 % of the same when ever they think proper
or can get the worth of it for the benefit
of the Family.

Item 4th It is my Will that my Wife give
to my minor Children as near as equal as she
can to those that has married also give to
Son in law James Bane a note I hold against
him -

Item 5th I do nominate and constitute and
appoint my beloved wife Mary Cullen and
Willis Stephens Executors and Executrix of this
my last will and testament and hereby
revoke and annul all former Wills by
me made -
