I therefore make and constitute this my
last will and testament

In the first place I resign my soul into the
hands of God who gave it and my body
to be Buried in a decent Christian burial
and as touching such worldly estate as it
hath pleased God to bless me with I
leave in the following manner, to wit

In the first place it is my desire that all
my just debts be paid

Secondly In Anna Heman the Wife of
Jedrick Heman I leave my bed and
furniture

Thirdly In my two Sisters Anna and Ruth
Heman I leave the balance of my Estate
both real and personal for their support
during their natural life

Fourthly At the death of my two Sisters
Anna and Ruth Heman I leave my
land to Jedrick Heman and his wife
Anna Heman

Fifthly The balance of my property if any I
have to Abby Heman I leave and
his wife ^{Anna} Heman are my Executors
and I entrust to ^{my} this my last will and
testament into effect

In the name of God amen
I Samue Bellum of the State of Georgia and
County of Madison being sick and weak in body
but sound of mind. And knowing that death
is appointed for all men to die. Do publish
this to be my last will and Testament - revoking
and disannulling all other wills by me made - In
pursuance I first it is my Will and desire That
my body be decently interred by my friends and
Christianity and I give and bequeath my soul to
Almighty God who gave it in hope of its glorious
resurrection with him.

Item 1st. It is my Will and desire that all my
last debts be paid out of my Estate and the
remainder to be disposed of in the following
manner.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my Wife
after my just debts be paid all the
balance of my Estate during her natural
life or Widow hood and in case she should
die many times the same to be equally divided
