Item I desire that all my just
debts including funeral expenses
and the expense of carrying out this
my last will be paid out of the
money left on hand at the time of my
death not otherwise herein after
disposed of

Item I give and bequeath to
My wife Susan and Emma
and Mr. Brown each the same
amount of personal property
and household stuff that Elizabeth
A. Daniel has already received
so that all may be equal
Item I do hereby bequeath my
personal property not disposed
of in Item 3rd shall be divided
into four equal lots as near as
can be and all of my children
shall draw for them each child
drawing one lot.

Item I have already given Elizabeth
A. Daniel her share of land by deed
and two hundred dollars worth of
Rail Road stock and will therefore
give her no further in respect to my
estate except as appears in Item 4th
above

Item I do hereby bequeath to
Susan and Emma and

21 Three hundred dollars
I turn & give all the land of which I
the crier and husband I give and
bequeath to my three children I mean
and Esmond and J. P. Moore as
trust in common so long as they
shall be unmarried. but if
Temona should marry there thirty eight
acres of said land shall be cut off
to her so as to leave the Horns and
and outbuildings on the remaining
which thirty eight acres on said
Contingency I give to her my
said daughter Temona in fee
simple the remaining one
hundred and thirty six acres.
I give in like manner to my
daughter Temona and my son
J. P. Moore

I turn & give and bequeath to
my daughter Temona my organ
I turn & give the residue of my property
not herein disposed of I give to my
four children each their one
share alike

I turn 10 I constitute and appoint
my son-in-law and my daughter
Temona known my executors to
carry this my last will into effect
without compensation for the same
