 myself and my family that I should make a disposi-
 tion of the property with which a kind providence
 has blessed me I therefore make this my last
 will & testament hereby revoking and annulling
 all others heretofore made by me

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a
 decent Christian like manner suitable to my cir-
 cumstances and condition My soul I trust shall
 return to rest with God who gave it as I hope
 for eternal salvation through the blessed Lord and
 Savior Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed
 and as I humbly trust have enjoyed for many years
 I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
 without delay by my Executor & Executors hereinafter
 named as I am unwilling that my Creditors should be
 delayed of their rights especially as there is no necessity
 for delay

Having heretofore given to my beloved daughter Mary
 Elizabeth one Horse Bridle and Saddle one bed, bedstead

And Furniture One pine table one trunk one boom two Cans and Calves two sows and fifteen pigs one clock and one negro Girl twelve Years of age I do hereby Confirm and Make permanent the above named gifts to my beloved daughter Mary Elisabeth and her heirs forever

Item Fourth Having heretofore given to my beloved son John Wingate one Horse Break & saddle one negro boy named Ellis valued at Seven Hundred & fifty dollars less two hundred and fifty dollars which my said son John Wingate has paid me two or as said negro boy Ellis I do hereby Confirm and Make permanent said gifts which I have heretofore given as above enumerated to my beloved son John Wingate and his heirs forever

Item Fifth I do hereby give to my beloved son John Wingate in addition to what I have already given him as above mentioned so much of my estate as will make the gift equal in value to the gifts heretofore made and hereby Confirmed to my beloved daughter Mary Elisabeth to my beloved son John Wingate and his heirs forever

Item Sixth I do hereby give and bequeath to my beloved son Isaac one year board two Courses of Lectures at some College instituted for that purpose within the State of Georgia or elsewhere the expenses of said board for one year and the above mentioned lectures to comprise two full Courses to be paid out of my estate And I do further give and bequeath to my beloved son Isaac in addition to the above named gifts enough of the effects of my estate to make up to him an amount equal in value to the gifts heretofore made and herein Confirmed and made permanent to my daughter Mary Elisabeth to my said son Isaac and his heirs forever

Item Seventh I do hereby give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah Nelson in addition to what she may have had since the time of her marriage enough of the effects of my estate to make up to my said daughter Sarah Nelson an amount equal in value to the gifts heretofore Confirmed and herein made permanent to my beloved daughter Mary Elisabeth to my beloved daughter Sarah Nelson and her heirs forever

Item Eighth I do hereby give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Leah Lydia to my beloved son James Mellem to my beloved son Samuel Nelson to my beloved daughter Parmelia Caroline and to my beloved daughter Martha Rebecca to each one of them individually and respectively whose names are mentioned and inserted in the foregoing part of this the eighth item of this my last will and testament so much of the effects of my estate as will make to each one of them individually a legacy equal in value to the gifts heretofore made and enumerated in the three items of this my last will and

Testament to my beloved daughter Mary Elizabeth to my
beloved daughter Leah to my beloved son James William
my beloved son Daniel Nelson to my beloved daughter
Tharmelia Caroline and my beloved daughter Martha Rebecca
to each one of them the amount of the above named legacy
each one to receive the legacy herein made at the time
they may arrive at the age of Twenty One or marry the
legacy to be held in reserve for each one of them by the
Executor & Executrix hereinafter named to each of them
and their heirs forever.

Memorandum After the payment of my debts and the legacies herein
before mentioned at the time they may fall due by my Executor
& Executrix hereinafter named I give and bequeath to
my beloved wife Sarah I Hall all the balance of my
estate both real & personal wherever & whatever it may
be whether land negroes horses hogs cows corn fodder
house hold and kitchen furniture plantation tools or any other
species of property whatever to use in any way she may
think fit and proper with the right to keep and reserve
any portion of my real & personal estate she may wish
and which she believes will best conduce to the interest
maintenance and support of herself and family with
the right to dispose of the remaining balance of my estate
by distribution at any time she may desire so to do
provided said distribution be made equal among my
beloved children & provided further that she reserve
enough of the remaining balance of my estate to
maintain and support my minor children until
they arrive at the age of Twenty One or marry
I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Sarah I Hall and my Brother Martin I Davis as
Executor & Executrix to this my last will & Testament with
full and ample power to dispose of my real & personal
estate or any portion thereof that they may deem wise; any
either by public or private sale as they my beloved
wife Sarah I Hall as Executrix and my Brother Martin
I Davis as Executor may deem right & proper to carry
out the provisions herein before contained in this
my last will & Testament this the 11th September
1844.
