 Memory but knowing that according to the Course of
 Nature my earthly existence must shortly terminate
 do hereby make and constitute this my last will and testa-
 ment. Revoking all others and I do dispose of all
 my earthly possessions in the following manner
 to wit

Item 1st To my beloved wife Eliza Reddock I do hereby give
 and bequeath my Negro Man Willis the Carpenters
 tools my Negro woman Letty and my Negro boy
 Abram also the North half of lot of Lewis Number
 (42) Forty two and the South half of lot Number (24)
 Twenty four. Known as the Reaser place both situate
 lying and being in the 4th Fourth district of originally
 Muscogee but now Marion County in said State with
 the improvements thereon also two mules such as she may
 choose out of my stock of Mules three Cows & Calves
 and two Sows and pigs such as she may select from
 my stock of Cattle and hogs also as much of my
 household and kitchen furniture as she wants and as
 many of my Farming tools as she may choose also
 two hundred Bushels of Corn Two thousand pounds of
 Hodder and Two thousand pounds of Pork also my
 Oxen and Cart and my pleasure Carriage all of the
 above mentioned property to be hers during her natural
 life but at her death whatever of it may remain
 shall be sold and divided out equally among my
 children which are hereinafter named viz Alexander
 Reddock Margaretta Hamrick Betty Henderson
 Huchin Reddock James Reddock Caroline Wheeler
 Emeline Reddock Emily Reddock Martha Ann
 Sanders Amanda Martin and Frances Perry

Item 2nd To my son Alexander Reddock I do hereby give and
 bequeath my Negro Man Ben and my Negro Girl Ellen

Item 3rd To my daughter Margaretta Hamrick during her natural
 life and to her children at her death I do hereby give and
 bequeath my Negro Woman Anet

Item 4th To my daughter Polly Ladenhead I do hereby give and
 bequeath my Negro woman Sarah

Item 5th To my daughter Betty Henderson during her natural
 life and at her death to her children I do hereby
 give and bequeath the sum of Eight hundred
 dollars Cash

- Item 6th To My Daughter Nancy Toney I do hereby give and bequeath the sum of Twenty dollars in cash.
- Item 7th To My Son Kimchin Reddock I do hereby give and bequeath a lot of land situate lying and being in the County of Carroll & state aforesaid known and distinguished in the plan of the (4th) fourth district of said County as lot Number (67) sixty seven also the balance he is owing me on accounts.
- Item 8th To My Son James Reddock I do hereby give and bequeath My Negro Woman Eady and her Daughter Ann
- Item 9th To My Daughter Caroline Wheeler I do hereby give and bequeath during her life time and at her death to her Children My Negro Girl Susan and My Negro Boy Joseph
- Item 10th To My Daughter Emeline Reddock during her natural life and to her Children at her death (should she have any) I do hereby give and bequeath My Negro Girl Vena and My Negro Boy George also one Bed & Furniture
- Item 11th To My Daughter Emily Reddock during her natural life and to her Children at her death I do hereby give and bequeath My Negro Boy John and My Negro girl Admilla
- Item 12th To My Daughter Martha Ann Sanders during her natural life and at her death to her Children I do hereby give and bequeath My Negro Woman Eliza and her Child Rissy
- Item 13th To My Daughter Amanda Martin during her natural life and at her death to her Children I do hereby give and bequeath My Negro Woman Adeline and her Child Bob
- Item 14th To My Daughter Frances Cory during her natural life and at her death to her Children I do hereby give and bequeath My Negro Boy Henry and My Negro girl Clarissa
- Item 15th As soon after my decease as it can conveniently be done it is my will and desire that my Executor shall proceed to sell all the balance or remainder of my property which is not disposed of above of every description both real estate and personal property and to collect all debts due me in any way and of every description and out of the money thus raised pay all my just debts, all burial expences and all the expences of executing this my last will and testament and the two cash legacies above specified and then distribute the balance that may be left or remaining among My Children

who are herein after named (viz) Alexander Reddock
Margarett Hamrick Hinchin Reddock James Reddock
Caroline Miles Emily Reddock Martha Ann Sanders Amanda
Martin and Frances Perry and the several distributive shares
of the said balance of money which goes to the females of the
above named heirs shall be theirs during their natural
life time but at their deaths shall be divided among these
Children

Item 11th I do hereby Nominate constitute and appoint my friend
and neighbor Charles McCall as my Executor to
execute and carry into effect this my last will and
testament
