Item first, I direct and desire that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter named

Item second I give and desire to my beloved wife Cherry the whole of my pro-
perty both real and personal after my just debts are paid for
her own use and for the support of the children I leave be-
hind and pray that she may be blessed in her exertions
for their welfare

Item third I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Cherry my sole
Executor to manage my property as she may think proper

I give and bequeath unto my wife Mary J. Tomblin all my
property both real and personal to wit, a negro stick of
all kind, house hold and kitchen furniture therewith other things
or things that may belong to the Estate. And the said Mary J.
Tomblin at her death to act and do with it as she may think
proper And I do by these presents constitute nominate and ap-
point Mary J. Tomblin my lawful Executor to this my last
will and testament.

I do hereby utterly disallow make & disannul all and every
other will & testament, legacy, bequeathes by me in any wise
before mentioned ratifying and confirming this and no other
to be my last will and testament.

ixed my seal in the presence of us This 12th day of August 1851
