Item first, I direct and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter named.

Item second I give and devise to my beloved wife Cherry the whole of my property both real and personal after my just debts are paid for her own use and for the support of the children I have be-
kind and pray that she may be blessed in her expectations for their welfare.

Item third I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Cherry my sole Executrix to manage my property as she may think proper.

Marion County } This being the last Will and Testament of Owen Tomblin he being in health and of a sound and disposable mind, makes the following disposition of his Estate to wit, after paying all my just debts I give and bequeath unto my wife Mary J. Tomblin all my property both real and personal to wit, (I am negroes stock of all kind, house hold and kitchen furniture) therewith other things or things that may belong to the Estate. And the said Mary J. Tomblin at her death to act and do with it as she may think proper. And I do by these presents constitute nominate and appoint Mary J. Tomblin my lawful Executor to this my last Will and Testament.

I do hereby utterly disavow revoke & disannul all and every other will & Testament, legacy, bequeaths by me in any way before mentioned ratifying and confirming this and no other or to be my last Will and Testament.
