State of Georgia: In the name of God Amen
Marion County 3. I Henry L. Allison of said
State and County being of sound mind and of
disposing memory deem it right and proper
both in respect of my family and myself
that I should make a disposition of the prop-
erty with which a kind Providence has blessed
me. I therefore make this my last Will and
testament

Item

1st I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and christian-like manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition in
life. my soul I trust shall return to rest with
God who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation
through the merits and atonement of the blessed
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Item

2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid as soon as convenient by my Executors hereinaf-
ter appointed.

Item

3^d I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Ruth
Allison all of my stock of Cattle, hogs and mules
my house hold and kitchen furniture, plantation
tools and wagon and all the provisions on hand
or in process of making at the time of my death
and I further will and bequeath to said wife
the west half of lot of land number (175) one hun-
dred and seventy five in the third district of
originally Muscogee now Marion County and
all profit, increase and advantage that may result
therefrom for and during her natural life

Item

4th I will and direct that my two minor chil-
dren viz: Martha E. and Jolicoffe Allison
be maintained and educated by my beloved
out of the proceeds of the property mentioned
and bequeathed to her in Item the third -
that is - say they shall be taught reading writing
and the most useful rules of Arithmetic

Item

5th It is my will and desire that all the rest
of my Estate not otherwise disposed of be equally
divided between my beloved wife and my sever-
al children and my grandson John C. Allison
share and share alike

Item

6th I will and direct that at the death of my
wife, Ruth, all the property both real and person-
al mentioned and bequeathed to my wife in
Item third and fifth that may remain after
my minor children shall have received the

Maintainance and education mentioned and designated in Item fourth, be equally be equally divided between all my children and grandson John L. Allison share and share alike-

Item 7th It is my will and desire and I do hereby appoint my two sons Henry L. Allison and Aaron L. Allison my Executors with full power and authority to execute this my last will and Testament this November 23rd Eighteen hundred and seventy one
