

Thus I want done by my Executors after the seventh day of September Eighteen hundred and fifty five at which time the said Thomas & Shupp will be twenty one years old then & I will and bequeath that my Executors shall have the power to dispose of my lands not adjoining the lands where I now reside viz three hundred three and three quarter acres better known as the Swain place together with one hundred & six and half of Camp ground at embracing also all lands which my executors shall cover as a whole I will that my Executors shall have the power to dispose of for the benefit of my estate as they may think best all said lands

Item I will that the property going from my estate to each of my daughters shall remain theirs individually for the benefit of themselves first and after their decease for the benefit of their children of their bodies

Item 10 I hereby appoint my worthy friends Hampton Morris and Johnson Springer Executors to this my last will and Testament
