I James Burke of said County and State being
of advanced age and feeble if body but it fit
bound and disposing mind do make right and
proper that I should make a distribution
of the property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me to make and ordain this to be
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
others heretofore made by me
Item first It will and desire that my body be buried
in a decent and becoming manner freely
trusting that my soul will return to God
who gave it and whose religion I have
professed for many years

Item second It will and I command to my beloved wife
Eliza Burke during her natural life the following
property to wit Lot of land number 18 Post
office in the 4th fourth district of originally
Buckee now Marion County it being the
place on which I now reside my house
was built about thirty four years ago by
a negro man Harton thirty three years old my
nurse woman Mary thirty five years old &
my negro servant Sarah about thirty five
years old also my carriage and two horses
big dog & Hart and one two Horse wagon
and all my household with kitchen furniture
after taking out of the same enough to make
my unmarried children equal to what has
been received by those who are married
Item third It is my will that my son William Washington
Burke have one good horse saddle and bridle to
be procured and furnished by my executor having the
name

Item fourth It is my will and desire that all the residue
of my estate of every kind and nature be
equally divided among my children and grand
children namely the son Francis C. Burke
my son William W. Burke my daughter Martha
Johnson wife of William C. Johnson
my daughter Sarah Ann Gordon wife of
Nicholas Gordon my daughter Harriet
Elizabeth Nelson wife of George Wilson
my daughter Mary W. Roberson wife of
John C. H. Roberson my daughter
Sarah Jane and Melinda it and that
the children of my son Andrew H.
Burke have the portion that said son
would be entitled to if in life

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the fifth I will and bequeath that all the portion
of my estate going my daughters above
named as well as what they may have in
their possession shall rest in them and
after their death to go to their Children to
be entirely free from the debts contracts and
liabilities both in law and equity of their
present or any future husband they may
have.

Item sixth I will and bequeath that the property named
in the second item for my beloved wife be equally
divided after her death among my children
as is provided for in the fourth item
of this will and that the division which
my daughters may receive be duly set to the
same conditions and restrictions.

Item seventh I hereby nominate and appoint my son
Francis O' Duke Executor to this my last
will and testament and I further appoint
him trustee for the property left to
my wife.

After writing whereof I have signed
and my hand and seal September the 15th
1855 James Duke

The foregoing will was signed sealed
declared and published by James Duke
in my presence as his last will and
testament and called on us to witness
the same & we sign the same in his
presence & in the presence of each
other this September 15th 1855

Marion County I John Burkhalter of said
County State being of sound mind and
disposing memory and knowing that there
is a law apposite for all men to die at
certain times and constitute this my last
will and testament hereby revoking all others
herefore made by me inconsistent with
the provisions of this will
- Item 1st It is my will and desire that Charles E.
Baptist be sold by me executor hereafter
named also my mother be sold to some person
of their choice for a fair price and the money
together with a boy called Gobles now of
the possession of Thomas may be given to
Eliza Lee during her life and at her death
to her children
- Item 2^d I will and bequeath and devise unto my
daughter Gertrude Burkhalter a sum of money
named Cagdace and in sum named Goloman
together with the plantation on which I
now reside together with all the stock and
artickles therein for and during her
natural life and at her death to her
children agreeably to the Statute of desis-
tement of this estate
- Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my son David
Ch Burkhalter he may by the name of Luke
and a negroe man by the name of Joe together
with all the stock and artickles of any description
now or hereafter belonging to the plantation
on the herein this property I also give
and bequeath unto the city of said Burkhalter
Burkhalter during his life and after his
death unto my grand son John Burkhalter
- Item 4th I give and bequeath unto the said John Burkhalter
my negroes I also give unto the said John Burkhalter my wife again
