I John Murray of said State and County being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart from this world deem it right and proper both as respects myself and my family that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me, I therefore make this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all others heretofore made by me.

Item first, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter named as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed of their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay.

Item second, I desire and direct that after all my just debts are paid that all my real and personal and divisible property remain in the possession of my beloved wife Milly, with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet and love for twenty seven years, until the youngest children be educated and become of age, and then I desire that my beloved wife Milly Murray take for her part lot of land number eighty eight in the ninth district of Houston County containing two hundred two and a half acres, with all rights members and appurtenances to said lot of land in any wise appertaining or belonging to the same and one or two negroes such as she may chose for her support during her natural life and then said property to be divided between the children with the increase that may arise from the same, also I desire that my wife Milly have or take such stock as horses, hogs, cattle as she may need. And the balance of the property to be equally divided among my children.

Item third, I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Milly Executrix and my worthy friend W. B. Bryan Executor to this my last Will and Testament this April 21st 1845.
