made It is my will and desire that all my last debts to paid to be executing herein after named as soon as convenient

And It is my will and desire that all my property be kept and worked together & my Executing in common for the benefit of my wife and children until my youngest child arrives at twenty one and then to be equally divided between my wife and children share and share alike but in case my wife should marry during the minority of my children then a division is to take place as provided in the first part of this

Will It is my will and desire and I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved wife Frances Eyr Executrix to this my last Will and Testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14th April 1862

for her services I direct that she have a support
during her natural life or widowhood.

5th I hereby constitute and appoint my friend
George Bowers and my beloved wife Mary
Lusk Executors of this my
last Will and Testament

Lusk as his last Will and Testament in the presence
of the undersigned who subscribe our names
hereto in the presence of said Testator at
his special instance and request and in
the presence of each other this 4th day of
August 1862
