LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JAMES T. RUTHERFORD  
STATE OF GEORGIA, COUNTY OF MARION.

I, James T. Rutherford of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1

Wish my Executor as seen as possible after my death to pay my debts.

Item 2

I give to my beloved wife, Mattie, the following property to-wit:- the house and household goods and the house that Tommy now lives in together with ten (10) acres of land around the houses off of lot of land No. 99 in the 10 Dist. and all the chickens and Ninety (90) acres of land the same being the north half of lot No 99 in the 10 Dist. one third of the hogs of her choice, two (2) cows one name Bless, one name Pet, one heifer yearling, one mare mule name Derah, one buggy and harness and all the farming implements and all the money I have on hand at my death. My wife, Mattie is to have and hold all of the aforementioned property during her lifetime or widowhood at her death or marriage then all of the aforementioned property to be divided among T. F. Rutherford and Baldwin J. Rutherford their heirs and assigns. I give to my son Tommy One Hundred (100) acres of land off of lot No 98 in the 10th Dist. the same being the West half of said lot and one horse name George, one set plow gear one hundred bushels corn, one third of the hogs, one third of the cows One Hundred Dollars in money to come out of notes due me. I give to my son Baldwin One Hundred acres of land off of lot No 99 in the 10 Dist Marion county the same being the South half of said No 99 in the 10th Dist said County and one Black mare mule name Bell one third of the hogs, and one third of the cows one two horse wagon Owensberrre make. I want my wife, Mattie, to have One Hundred (100) bushels corn and if there is any corn left after Mattie and Tommy gets theirs I want my son Baldwin to have it all. When the cotten that is made on my place this year 1910 is gathered I want my son Baldwin to take charge of it and pay my debts and the balance that is left to be equally divided between my wife, Mattie, Tommy and Baldwin. I want my wife Mattie, to have all the cotten seed. I want my son Baldwin to collect all the notes that is due me and pay my son Tommy One Hundred Dollars, and the Four Hundred Dollars my son Baldwin owes me now I want him to have all of it. In testimony whereof I have hereto set my hand this the 12 day of April 1910. I do hereby appoint J. B. Rutherford Executor of this my Will.


