Rutherford and Baldwin J. Rutherford their keirs and assigns. I give to my son Temmy One Hundred (100) acres of land off of lot No 98 in the loth Dist. the same being the West half of said let and one horse name George, one set plow goar one hundred bushels eern, one third of the hogs, one third of the cows One Hundred Dellars in memey to come out of notes due me.
