

J St Jarvis Deed

Pineville, Marion County Georgia

I James St Jarvis being advanced in age do make and constitute this my last will and testament to dispose of what worldly effect I may have left on hand at my death

Item 1st. I desire all my just debts be paid at as early day as possible and that my grave be done up with a suitable monument and to be enclosed with iron railing not to cost over two hundred and fifty dollars

Item 2d. I give to my brothers three sons, to wit William E. Jarvis, Robert Jarvis and David St Jarvis Janr. Six Hundred Dollars each they live near Richford Station Gibson County Tennessee and, to my sister son Daniel F. Basset Six Hundred Dollars he lives near Farmington Davie County N.C. I give one hundred dollars to the grave yard near New Bethel Church near Pineville P.O. for the purpose of assisting the citizens in fencing the grave yard when it come to be necessary to do so

Item 3rd. After paying out the above and the expensary that may be incurred in doing so I give the balance that may be left to be equally divided between the seven children of M. L. Bivins and M. C. Bivins I will not name them here when they arrive to the age of twenty one or get married I appoint Mrs. M. C. Bivins to be trustee for them that are under age she is not to make any Return to the Court of Ordinary only give my Executor a Receipt for the amount paid to her for them children

Item 4th. I appoint my friend, Mr. B. F. Mattheew to be my Executor to carry out this my will
