executors as soon as convenient

Item 3 I will and bequeath after my debts are paid  
all of my property perishable real and personal at least  
in the hands of my beloved wife Elizabeth & Queen  
for the benefit of all my family so long as she remains  
a widow or until some one of my children marries  
or arrives to the age of twenty one years I further des  
that my mother in law Mrs Sarah Hipp have a home  
with my family and her support out of all my ex  
ceeding life after her own individual means are ex  
tended

Item 4 I will unto my beloved wife Elizabeth & Queen  
an equal portion of my estate with my children & he  
ir marriage should the wish to marry the property & giving  
her out of my Estate to remain at her despatch

Item 5 I will that each of my children without distinction  
have a good English education to be paid out of my  
estate amounting together as my executors may see they sin  
ally require

Item 6 I will and bequeath that each of my children  
as they shall marry or come to the age of twenty  
one years shall have three respective thirds paid to the  
rest of my whole estate I desire that my Daughter to  
be given to have one hundred Dollars Extra in consequence  
of her wants also

Item 7 I direct my executors to make copies and deliver  
unto Thomas A Hipp two promissory notes one of the face value  
and fifty Dollars payable twenty fifth of December less than  
any legatee and fifty five the other for the sum of  
three hundred and fifty Dollars due twelve after the  
most tenor note Each note to be paid out of the whole  
sum out of my estate and further I will that my  
executors demand of the said Thomas A Hipp an am  
ount of working covering a good and sufficient let to  
his interest in the estate of Mark Hipp in case of Lincoln  
County Marion County Mill Bk 184 p 154 this conveyance for what

the above named notes are to be given it being  
a previous contract between myself and the said  
Thomas A Hipp

This I want done by my Executors after the sixteenth day  
of September eighteen hundred and fifty four at which time  
the said Thomas A. Shipp will be twenty one years old  
Item 8 I will and bequeath that my Executors shall have  
the power to dispose of my lands not adjoining the lands  
where I now reside viz. three hundred three and three quarter  
acres better known as the farm place together with one  
hundred acres east half of camp ground lot embracing  
also all lands which my executors shall leave as a residue  
I will that my Executors shall have the power to dispose  
of for the benefit of my Estate as they may think best  
all said lands

Item 9 I will that the property gaging from my Estate to  
each of my daughters shall remain their in consideration  
for the benefit of themselves first and after their decease  
for the benefit of their children of their bodies

Item 10 I hereby appoint my worthy friends Thompson Morris  
and Jameson Springer Executors to this my last will and  
testament
