Item 1 I desire that my body be decently buried my
 sole bequeath to God who gave it

Item 2 I desire that all my just debts be paid by my
 Executors as soon as convenient

Item 3 I will and bequeath after my debts are paid
 all of my property perishable real and personal now
 in the hands of my beloved wife Lucinda & Quincy
 for the benefit of all my family so long as she is
 a widow or until some one of my children marries
 as soon as the age of twenty one years I further desire
 that my mother-in-law Mrs Sarah Shipp have a home
 with my family and her support out of all my income
 during her life after her own individual means are gone

Item 4 I will unto my beloved wife Lucinda & Quincy
 an equal portion of my Estate with my children & he
 marriage should she wish to marry the property gaining
 her out of my Estate to remain at her discretion

Item 5 I will that each of my children without distinction
 have a good English Education to be paid out of my
 Estate unwearily together as my Executors may see they
 really require

Item 6 I will and bequeath that each of my children
 as they shall marry or come to the age of twenty
 one years shall have their respective shares paid to them
 out of my whole Estate I desire that my Daughter
 Maria Quincy have one hundred Dollars Extra in consequence
 of her weak arm

Item 7 I desire my Executors to make Exchequer and deliver
 unto Thomas A Shipp two promissory notes one for four hundred
 and fifty Dollars payable twenty fifth of December one thousand
 and eight hundred and eighty five The other for the sum of
 three hundred and fifty Dollars due twelve months after the
 mentioned note Cash note to be paid out of the whole
 and out of my Estate and further I will that my
 Executors demand of the said Thomas A Shipp an
 amount of money conveying a good and sufficient title to
 his interest in the Estate of Mark Shipp late of Lincoln
 County Georgia as well as the consideration for which
 the above mentioned notes are to be given it being
 a previous contract between myself and the said
 Thomas A Shipp

This I want done by my Executors after the twentieth day of September Eighteen hundred and fifty five at which time the said Thomas & Shepp will be Twenty One years old then I will and bequeath that my Executors shall have the power to dispose of my lands not adjoining the lands where I now reside viz Three hundred three and three quarters acres better known as the Swamp place together with one hundred Acres East half of Camp Ground at embracing also all lands which my coheirs shall leave as a Solace I will that my Executors shall have the power to dispose of for the benefit of my Estate as they may think best all said lands

Item 9 I will that the property going from my Estate to each of my daughters shall remain theirs individually for the benefit of themselves first and after their decease for the benefit of their children or their bodies

Item 10 I hereby appoint my worthy friends Hampton Morris and Adams Springer Executors to this my last will and Testament
