age but of sound mind and Memory know-
ing that I must shortly depart this life
do in it right and proper form as respects
myself and my family that I should
make a disposition of the property with
which a kind Providence has blessed me
and therefore make this my last Will and
testament hereby revoking and annulling
all others by me heretofore made

First I desire and direct that my
body be buried in a decent and
Christian like manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life
My soul I trust shall return to rest
with God who gave it.

Second I desire and direct that all
my just debts be paid by my Executors
hereinafter appointed.

Third - I give and bequeath to my
loved wife Cynthia Passmore one
thousand dollars in Gold, said Gold to
remain in the hands of W A Guthrie
to be paid out by him for the use and
support of my said wife, and if there
should be any of said Gold left after
her death to - equally divided be-
tween my son Abner Passmore and
my daughter Jane Guthrie. Provided
my wife should live longer than I
do & if she should dy before I do
then said Gold to return as part of
my Estate and to be divided as the
rest of the estate is divided.

I also give to my wife two Beds
and Bedsteads and furniture and the
bed and furniture known as my
bed & give to Letta Guthrie my grand
child

Fourth - I give and bequeath to the

heirs of my deceased son Edmund Passmore one dollar

Fifth: I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth, Bill and her children by, Eight part of my estate after my wife's part is taken out

Sixth: I give and bequeath to the heirs of my deceased daughter Rebecca Smith One Eight part of my estate after my wife's part is taken out,

Seventh: I give and bequeath to the children of my deceased daughter Liddy Snow one Eight part of my estate after my wife's part is taken out.

Eighth: I give and bequeath unto my son Josephus Passmore Jr. One Eight part of my estate after my wife's part is taken out. But my son Josephus Passmore Jr. shall take the following as money

One note on himself for Seventy six dollars due one day after date and dated Feb 13, 1867, Also one himself for Seven for dollars with a credit of five dollars dated the 19th Nov. 1867, Also three Notes of John Passmore and himself amounting to two hundred Twenty Two dollars dated 31 January 1874, and due 1st of Oct. 1874. If said notes in notes is not paid before my death.

Ninthly: I give and bequeath to my deceased daughter Liddy Smith's children one dollar

Tenthly: I give and bequeath to my son Abner Passmore one Eight part of my estate after my wife's part is taken out

Eleventhly: I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne Smith and her children by me a fourth of the balance of my

Abner Passmore and my son-in-law Wm. A. Guthrie
my Executors to the my last Will and Tes-
