- Item 3. I give bequeath and devise to my daughter S. A. W. Aperson \$5.00 five dollars at my death.
- Item 4. I give to my daughter Mary C. Bump \$5.00 five dollars at my death.
- Item 5. I give to my daughter Francis Lancaster \$25.00 Twenty five dollars at my death.
- Item 6. I give to my daughter Emma Hendrick \$50.00 Fifty dollars at my death.
- Item 7. I give to my daughter J. E. Brooks \$50.00 fifty dollars at my death.
- Item 8. I give to my daughter Dinantha Wells 1 Cow + Calf at my death.
- Item 9. I give to my wife C. E. Hand to my daughter C. E. Hand to my daughter M. E. Hand S. T. Hand my daughter J. W. Hand my son H. T. Hand. If he my son Frank Hand marries not Elizabeth Benson he shall have full share with my wife C. E. Hand my daughter Martha Hand my daughter Dinantha Wells my daughter Antona Hand my daughter John Hand my son in the land with the exception of the Hundred dollars he has had.
- If my son Frank Hand does marry the afore said Elizabeth Benson I will + bequeath him five dollars only to be paid him at my death. All of my lands is to be

kept till the death of my wife but two lots of land 62 + 63 which is to be sold for the use of my family at home for their benefit. All of my stock is for the use and benefit of my family at home all the money after my debts are paid is to be divided between my wife Eliz my daughter Martha my daughter Jennie my daughter and John my son given to them as they come of age.

I wish my wife Elizabeth and Martha to have their part of all the money that is left at my death and John + Emma shall have theirs as they come of age. at the death of my wife the lands shall be divided between Elizabeth, Hells, Martha John and Jennie and if Frank marries not Eliza Benson he also shall have equal share of the lands left at the death of my wife.

I Joseph Stand hereby constitute and appoint my wife and W. C. Stand my daughter Executives to carry out all my wills.
